GLOBAL AUTISM STUDY 2015

A large global study on Autism will start in January 2015. For a period of 2 years, 93 NAET practitioners (www.naet.com) around the world will conduct the study on a group of around 800 autistic children (ages 2 to 10) to determine the effectiveness of NAET in Autism Spectrum Disorder. Earlier published research showed dramatic improvement, with 23/30 children receiving treatment being able to return to regular schools (vs 0/30 in the untreated control group). Please go to:

Before entering the study, children must have a diagnosis of Autism from a psychologist, neurologist or a psychiatrist. If the children have high IgE readings on foods they will not be admitted to the study. Children will not be charged at any moment during the study except for some low charges on the initial IgE level test. Transportation fees are to be refunded at the end of the study.

The children will be treated once or twice a week over 4 to 6 months for 38 key groups of allergens. Treatments are simple, non-invasive and gentle, using acupressure and taking around 30 minutes. The children are permitted to continue their usual therapies they were on prior to entering the study.
